Guidelines for Receiving Holy Communion
Catholics fully participate in the celebration of the Eucharist when they receive
Holy Communion in fulfillment of Christ's command to eat His body and drink His blood. In order to be disposed properly to receive communion, communicants should not be conscious of grave sin, have fasted for at least one hour, and seek to live in charity and love with their neighbors.

Also recall that the Church asks us to consume the Host, the Body of our Lord, in the presence of the minister. Thank you.

Guidelines for Other Christians

We welcome to the Celebration of the Eucharist those Christians who are not fully united with us. It is a consequence of the sad divisions in Christianity that we cannot extend to them a general invitation to receive communion. Catholics believe that Eucharist is an action of the celebrating community signifying a oneness in faith, life, and worship of the community. Reception of the Eucharist by Christians not fully united with us would imply a oneness which does not yet exist, and for which we must all pray.

Guideline for Those Not Receiving Communion

Those not receiving sacramental communion may come forward, cross their hands across their chest and receive a blessing.

History of Sacramental Oil

It has long been tradition in our church to pray and anoint with oil. There are two types of oil: (1) Holy sacramental oil and (2) Blessed oil. The Holy sacramental oil is used ONLY BY BISHOPS, PRIESTS, AND DEACONS in the administration of the sacraments. The Blessed oil is simply blessed and used by all. It is used for praying for healing.

Blessed Oil

Oils bought in bookstores or religious article stores are not blessed. Be sure to have the oil blessed after purchase. Oil will be blessed by our priests during the Liturgy on Saturday.


