Pope Francis:

The Devil is Real and He Must Be Fought

Christian life is a constant battle against the devil, who is not the stuff of legend, but really exists, Pope Francis has said in a recent homily.

Battling the devil will not be easy because the evil one's traps and temptations are many, and "the devil is not tossing flowers at us," but "flaming arrows" aimed to kill, the Pope said during a Mass in the Domus Sanctae Marthae where he lives.

There are three "enemies of Christian life," Pope Francis said: "The devil, the world and the flesh," in other words, the carnal passions that are "the wounds of original sin."

"But this generation, and many others, made people think that the devil was a myth, a character, an idea, the concept of evil," the Pope said, according to Vatican Radio.

"The devil exists and we have to fight against him. Paul says so—I'm not the one saying it. The word of God says it," the Pope added, referring to the day's reading from St Paul's Letter to the Ephesians (6:10-20), which calls on believers to "stand firm against the tactics of the devil".

Even believers "are not too

convinced" the devil exists, he said, or else "we are a bit lazy in the fight and we let ourselves be led by our passions, by some temptations. It's because we are sinners — all of us."

"However, do not be discouraged. (Have) courage and strength because the Lord is with us" and supplies all that is needed in battle, the Pope said.

Because the devil is "the father of lies, the father of deception," Christians must arm themselves with the "armor of God — the truth."

St. Paul says Christians must be "girded in truth, clothed with righteousness as a breastplate, and your feet shod in readiness for the Gospel of peace," the Pope said. People need to "hold faith as a shield" and take up "the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God," he added, and they must pray all the time.

"You cannot be Christians without working continuously at being righteous. You can't," the Pope continued.

People need faith to go forward and they need to know "that it is God defending us, to resist the



devil's temptations," he said.

"Is that clear? You cannot think of a spiritual life, a Christian life," he said, "without resisting temptation, without fighting against the devil, without putting on this armor of God, who gives us strength and defends us."

"Christian life is a battle, a very beautiful battle because when the Lord wins at every step of our life, he gives us a joy, a great happiness, that joy that the Lord has won in us" with his free gift of salvation, the Pope said.

He looked at me and said: "Start asking people to fast for this! It's very important that as many people as possible do some form of fasting one day each week from now until the Convention!" I knew he was absolutely right and that there is no time to waste!

Once I was browsing in a bookstore's Religion section. Two women were also there and were carrying on a not-so-quiet conversation. One of them remarked that she was in the midst of a fast. The other woman immediately replied: "Let me fast together with you. What is your prayer intention?" I was in total amazement! Never in my life have I come across anyone so eager and willing to join in a fast!

If Jesus fasted during his earthly ministry, how very important must it also be for those who follow in Christ's footsteps. Fasting channels God's Power in a most pronounced way. How Should We Fast?

There is no one set pattern for fasting. How we choose to fast is a choice of one's own heart. It depends on the level of our ability and availability.

Possible Suggestions

- Eliminate 1 or 2 meals on your fast day.
- Cut out selected items from your diet on your fast day. Such



as desserts, snacks or meat.

 Abstain from something other than food. Perhaps fasting from watching TV or time spent on a hobby.

Remember the object of fasting is not just to give something up, but to make room for prayer.



Try this for a mind-boggler: All the molecules in a drop of water far exceed the number of all humans that ever existed. Let the number of all the molecules in the earth's oceans represent all the humans who could exist but never will. You and I became molecules in that single drop when God "called" us into existence (Rom 4:17; Rev. 4:11). That "call" makes each of us incredibly special to God!

But he didn't stop there. He called each of us to holiness (1 Th. 4:3; John 17:19) from an ocean of ungodliness to be his chosen heritage (Ps. 33:12). From heaven he watches each of us (v.14) who are called by another call to that same heaven (Heb. 3:1; 1 Th. 2:12) to enjoy eternal bliss beyond description (2 Cor. 12:4; 1 Cor. 2:9). That makes us super-special to God!

Furthermore, you are so special that he provides grace for you to "live a life worthy of your calling" (Eph. 4:1) to "make your calling and election sure...for a rich welcome into the eternal kingdom" (2 Pet. 1:10-11), "the eternal life to which you were called" (1 Tim. 6:12),

Have you stretched your imagination far enough to be awestruck at God's special love for
